The award will recognize young, emerging leaders of the ASDS who have demonstrated commitment to the Society's growth and success. Candidates will be ASDS members in good standing. They will have been out of residency for one to ten years and have volunteered their time and effort to the ASDS/ASDSA for a minimum of three consecutive years in multiple capacities, i.e. involved in projects, on committees and work groups, as faculty, etc.

- ✓ Participation in ASDS skin cancer screening programs
- ✓ Development of new programs or services for the ASDS or ASDSA
- ✓ Participated in educational programs
- ✓ Service as a representative to the Board or AMA
- ✓ Participation in the Future Leaders Network

Rules for Nomination

- Candidates must be members in good standing of ASDS and out of residency for one to ten years.
- Candidates may only be nominated by members in good standing of ASDS.
- Candidates must not self-nominate or be nominated by their spouse or domestic partner.
- Candidates must not be a current member of the Award Work Group.

To nominate an individual, submit the nominee's name, along with a detailed summary of the nominee's sustained service to the ASDS and/or ASDSA. The nomination must be seconded by an ASDS member.
